


Some will want the Seashore, some the Woodlands, while others must have their swimming, tennis and hikes, while still more demand boating and fishing.

take Linden Boulevard and Sunrise Highway (Route 27) to Main Street in Patchague.**

from NEW YORK

from BRONX

via Queensboro Bridge and Oueens Boulevard

via Tri-Boro Bridge

and then follow Grand Central Parkway to Westbury. Continue on Jericho Turnpike (Route 25) to Coram.
Turn right on traffic light at Coram, take Route 112, which will bring you to the Main Street of Patchague.


*In Patchague—continue east on Main Street to the point where the road forks, take the right hand road reading to "Bellport." One mile from this point on the right hand side of the road you will see a sign Patchague Shores. Office is a few feet off road.




Another all-the-year-round House with 2 bedrooms, living room, bathroom, kitchen, screened porch and oil burner heat, as well as an open fireplace.




Another Log Cabin with two bedrooms, kitchen, dining room, bathroom with tub, outside shower and screened porch.

comfort to your desire; something to do all the time for everyone whatever your particular mood. Yet Patchogue Shores is within easy commuting distance from New York by train and is quickly and pleasantly reached by automobile traveling on the best of Long Island's splendid highways.

Here are no crowds on the private beach, a clean inviting strech of white sand, without stone or pebble. As you wade into the refreshing water you observe the sandy bottom causes no discomfort to the feet, as it gently slopes away without abrupt drops or changes of depth so often encountered at other beaches.

A wide fenced-off pool gives protection to all, with a shallow place for the children on one side and a deeper swimming pool on the other. Really, the best in bathing and swimming is to be had here with the water always comfortable and invigorating, coming as it does from the distant Atlantic Ocean beyond Fire Island, which forms one arm of the Great South Bay. Grassy green lawns rise from the shoreline gently back to the Club House, where full catering to all your needs is

available, even to periodic dances, parades and meetings of various kinds. Indeed, there are so many advantages which are offered to Patchague Shores residents that it is impossible to describe them all.

As is well known, water frontage is rapidly becoming scarce particularly in localities close enough to the City to permit of commuting. Here, at Patchague Shores, it is still possible to buy a home, at a price well within the reach of the average income. Although it is in proximity to some of the finest Estates on Long Island, prices are almost unbelieving low.

Away from the crowds and traffic, protected from every undesirable element and encroachment it is an ideal vacation spot for young and old. The single motor entrance is fully quarded to ensure privacy for the members of the community.

Excellent water is piped to your home, telephone and electricity are available at low cost, and garbage is collected. Approved tradesmen call at your door daily for orders, yet canvassers and peddlers are not allowed on the estate. Your own private




, there is much to be said for a week-end at Patchague Shores with ice-skating and similar sports available.



For All Houses Shown on the Following Pages

EXTERIOR: California Redwood, Colonial Siding, Batton Siding, or Log Cabin Siding of 2" logs. Exterior finish Sherman-Williams Grade A paint. Plots suitably land-scaped.

FOUNDATION: Concrete or equal.

WINDOWS: Casement or double hung type with bronze screens.

SCREENS: Bronze screens on porches, windows and doors.

HARDWARE: Bronze or galvanized.

FLOOR: 2" x 6" and 2" x 8' beams - narrow clear flooring.

FIREPLACE: Brick or Fieldstone, some with built-in heatalator equipped with electric draw fans.


ROOF: Bird Shingles — 20 year Guarantee. Copper flashing in Valleys, lead flashing on chimney.

PLUMBING: Complete plumbing (running water, toilet, basin, shower, or tub, or both. Sink and cabinet combinations in kitchen, outside lawn faucets.) Modern concrete sewage disposal.


ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS: Rustic type fixtures, chain pull lights. Ample outlets in all rooms and porch.

WATER: Water mains through all streets.

INTERIOR FINISH: Knotty pine celotex or veneer panelling, fully lined. All rooms complete with doors and hardware. Ample closet and storage space.





Log Cabin — with 2 Bedrooms, Living room, Kitchen and Bathroom with shower.






Small model Log Cabin — with 2 Bedrooms, Living Room, Kitchen, Dinette, Bathroom with outside shower and screened parch.
